Responsibilities include boosting teen engagement at Ringling College's Sarasota Art Museum (SAM) campus. This includes helping teens/tweens explore their creativity through summer studio sessions. Courses taught include: Character Design and Cartooning, Painting, Printmaking, Fundamentals of Drawing, and Introduction to Sculpture and 3D Design. In addition to teaching, I have also written the curriculum for the museum's middle school educational programing. My most involved duty for the college is my role as the Lead Instructor of the Sarasota Art Museum's Teen Arts Council (SAM TAC). This position allows me to oversee a group of creative high school students who share a common interest in art and community engagement. The Teen Arts Council gets behind-the-scenes access to the Museum; assists in planning Teen Nights, events, and other public programming; and learns about the Museum's exhibitions and contemporary art.
